### PERFORMANCE CHARACTERISTICS

**OUTSTANDING RUGGEDNESS:** This TOUGH turf-type fescue is great for golf course fairways or roughs or for shady lawns—even in high erosion areas. **MX-86** is a grass that looks good and requires very little maintenance.

**NOW WITH ENDOPHYTE ENHANCEMENT:** **MX-86** is the new endophyte-enhanced version of the original **MX-86**, making it the world's first sheep fescue variety with endophyte. Endophyte is a natural biological system for insect control.

**LOW GROWTH PROFILE:** **MX-86** is one of the few turfgrasses that can even be grown without mowing! Its low growth profile seldom exceeds ankle height. With a once-a-year trim mowing of the seedheads in late spring, it provides the closest thing to a no-mow lawn.
